COVID-19 Mitigation
Guidance for Facility Use

Gathering In-Person:

Ministries should inform participants to wait to gather if they are sick, they've been around someone sick, or if they cannot risk getting sick. We want to mitigate the risk of spreading Covid-19, and we cannot eliminate all risk.

Masks:

Ministries should inform participants of Keystone's mask policy. Everyone should decide before the Lord whether or not to wear a mask. We believe God calls believers to obey ruling authorities as long as it does not cause us to sin; nevertheless, this is a decision for individuals to make, not the church.

Distancing:

Ministries should provide opportunities for participants to gather in responsible ways. Though we cannot guarantee all participants will abide by distancing precautions, we can provide the opportunity.

Tracing:

Ministries should inform participants that we will send an alert if we find out that someone has tested positive for Covid-19 after attending a Keystone event.

Temperature Checks:

Ministries should inform participants that we will use non-contact thermometers for temperature checks for all children & youth before ministry events. If anyone has a temperature of more than 100.4°F, they will need to stay home.

Etiquette:

Ministries should inform participants that we will provide hand sanitizer stations and encourage handwashing before and after interacting with each other.

Cleaning:

Ministries should use disinfectant and clean rags to wipe down frequently touched surfaces after the event—tabletops, door handles, etc. Supplies will be provided by Keystone—in Fellowship Hall North Closet in Worship Center & in Cleaning Closet Next to Women's Bathroom in Youth Center.
