Yemen's Hunger

1. **The Food Skeptics wished Jesus would Give.** John 6:30-31
2. **The Food the Savior wished the Skeptics would Want.** John 6:32-35
 - a. God's food.
 - i. Physical or spiritual needs most important?
 - b. I am *better* food: *true bread* from heaven. I come from heaven to give [the] life to world.
 - i. No more budgeting for food, no more grocery shopping, no more cooking. "oooh, that's the kind of bread I want!" (v.34)
 - ii. Come to Me & never be hungry again.

- o *Prayer is the catalyst for Gospel growth. It's been proven throughout history that God responds to the faithful and fervent prayers of His people.*
 - o *Of all Yemen's unreached, the **Hadhrami** are hardest to reach. They're difficult to access, probably now more than ever. There are fewer tools developed in their specific dialect of Arabic.* Nathaniel
